Following on from our phone conversation I remembered I had this old photo of the staff of Burns Laundry in Warren Road. There were two laundries on the site now occupied by the flats at the top of Cooper Road, the other being the Alexandra which lasted much later than Burns which I believe became the Guildford Laundry and re-located to the bottom of the town. There is no date on the photo but I would think it dates from the early 1920's. My granddad who lived in Addison Road for many years until 1960 is the one sitting in shirt sleeve, second row from the back. Also attached is a Surrey Advertiser photo taken at a Cork Club Christmas party my mum and dad attended, probably in the 1980s. I do not have an exact date. Apart from mum and dad, the only people I recall are the then landlord and landlady, Nellie Parker (head of the table) and Mrs Collyer who worked in the shop where you live in the 1950's, seated to Nellies left. Both lived in Addison Road and I believe it is Mrs Ellis, obscured by the wine glass who lived in the bungalow at the top of Addison Road where the new houses are now.
